# We're Building California's 1<sup>st</sup> Boys & Girls Club ON A COLLEGE CAMPUS

Boys & Girls Clubs of Huntington Valley is making history! We are building California's 1st Boys & Girls Club on a college campus.

Our new Boys & Girls Club will be located at Golden West College, a community college in Huntington Beach. We call the campaign to build this new Club "Building Dreams" because it will help make families' dreams of great futures come true!

This exciting project is already well underway. BGCHV completed the first of three phases of the Building Dreams campaign in January 2011 with the grand opening of the Robert Mayer Child Development Preschool. Two years later, the preschool and the kids we serve are thriving!

Now, BGCHV is kicking off the next phase of the campaign to raise an additional \$5 million to build a Club for school age kids and a gymnasium. When complete, the new Boys & Girls Club complex will be a "Family Campus" within the Golden West College campus. In addition to preschool programs, the new Family Campus will offer: before and after school programs for school age youth; full day programs during summer and school holidays; sports leagues and fitness programs; and family support services, including the Club's award winning Twilight Education Project. Whole families will benefit from the new Club. And, the location itself will enable parents to go back to school and inspire generations of kids to go to college.

To date, the Club has raised \$4.7 million toward the campaign's \$10 million goal, with an additional \$200,000 in pledges due over the next two years. With the first phase of the campaign fully funded, the Club is excited to embark on the next two phases of the campaign.
