Making a gift to the Building Dreams Campaign of the Boys and Girls Clubs of Huntington Valley is the best way to support our continued work in the community. However you choose to support us, you will be embarking on a partnership with one of the best Clubs in the world.

Unrestricted and Restricted Gifts

Gifts are either “restricted” or “unrestricted.” When you do not restrict the use of your gift, we gain crucial flexibility. Unrestricted gifts are used to meet changing or urgent needs such as construction or furnishings. A restricted gift is appropriate if you desire the funds to be used only for a designated purpose.

Outright or Pledged Gifts

Gifts may be given “outright” or payments may be made over time. Gifts of cash, securities or other property have an immediate impact on our campaign and are the organization’s preferred method of receiving support to this effort. Gifts paid over time are typically made through a “pledge.” Examples of outright and pledged gifts can include: cash, securities, real estate, other assets (closely held securities, art, collectibles, etc.), and in kind gifts.

Matching Gifts

Many corporations have demonstrated their support for us by matching, or multiplying, their employees’ gifts to the Club. Before you make a gift, consult your company’s personnel office for further information about matching programs.

Planned Gifts

Making a planned gift can be a very integral part of your estate planning. You should consult your tax advisor so you can maximize your tax planning opportunities. Examples of effective planned gifts can include:

- Bequests – Consider listing the Boys and Girls Clubs of Huntington Valley in your trust or will.
- Charitable Remainder Trusts – A charitable remainder trust, either through a charitable remainder unitrust (CRUT) or a charitable remainder annuity trust (CRAT), provides income to a non-charitable income beneficiary for a period of time (or life) and then pays the remainder to the charity.
- Charitable Lead Trusts – A charitable lead trust pays income first to a charity for a specified length of time and then pays the remainder to a non-charitable beneficiary.
- Endowments – An endowment gift is the establishment of a fund maintained in perpetuity where a portion of the annual investment return is used for a specific purpose while the rest of the investment yield is returned to principle.
