

By the time my daughter was born, I cleaned up. I found a new life, a job, a purpose. Everything was about finding a better life for my family.

After my second child was born, my wife left us. She was drug addicted, young and wanted to live her own life. Being a single dad didn't stop me. I worked long hours because I lived in LA and worked in Huntington Beach. Finally, I found a way to move here to Huntington Beach, but I needed child care. That's when I found the Boys & Girls Club.



The Club is a huge blessing. The Club actually cares about me. They relieve a lot of stress for me and my girls love it. But, I couldn't do it without the scholarship program. Because of donors like you, the Club gives me 50% off and that's something I can manage.

When I come to pick up my oldest and say it's time to go...she says, 'Daddy, go get Sophia first - I don't want to go home yet.' That makes my heart so happy to know she's in a place she loves every day.

Club Honors Shirley Dettloff as Champion of Youth



More than \$1.3 million of the Club's \$9 million annual budget comes from generous donors like you. One of the Club's most important fundraising days of the year is the "Great Futures Start Here" Annual Benefit Dinner and Auction held each October. Thanks to donors like you, this year's event on October 6 was a record breaker. More than 550 community members came together to raise \$526,000 for the kids!

The Club was proud to honor longtime volunteer Shirley Dettloff as our Champion of Youth at the event. Winners of the live auction items will be enjoying a trip to Thailand, a new ATV from Yamaha, a Thanksgiving vacation in Hawaii and lots more. The highlight of the evening was hearing from Club parents and Club

Event guests were so moved by their stories that they gave a record breaking \$158,000 when asked to Sponsor a Child at the Club. A surprise \$25,000 match from the Huntington Beach Auto Dealers Association for the first 25 \$1,000 gifts helped get the crowd excited and inspired to give.

Funds raised help subsidize EVERY child's participation in Boys & Girls Club

programs so that we can keep our fees at less than half the cost of the County average for after school programs. Not only that, funds raised at the event help give scholarships to low-income families and support free programs like the Oak View Branch and the Twilight Education Project.

Hyundai Helps the Boys & Girls Club Buses Get New Safety Features

Every day, about 1,000 children ride the Boys & Girls Club's fleet of buses to and from school. The Club's transportation program is unique among Boys & Girls Clubs in our area and helps the organization reach kids from 45 local elementary and middle schools, as well as bringing whole families from 25 local neighborhoods to the Club's Twilight Education Project in the evenings. Not only that, thanks to our fleet of 18 buses, the Club

can take kids on fun and educational field trips every day of our summer program. Carrying kids and families every day is a big responsibility and one that the Club takes very seriously. Children's safety is always Boys & Girls Clubs of Huntington Valley's #1 priority. That's why we're so grateful to Hyundai Motor America for helping make our bus fleet even safer.

This fall, Boys & Girls Clubs of Huntington Valley received a \$20,000 sponsorship from Hyundai Motor America to purchase and install a new child safety alert system for every bus. With the new alert system, when the bus has been turned off and a driver is getting ready to exit the vehicle, an alarm at the back of the bus has

to be manually turned off by the driver. As the bus driver walks to the back of the bus, he or she checks carefully to make sure that no child is left behind

on the bus. This new safety measure ensures that all kids are safe and supervised and no child is left in a vehicle unattended. Executive Director Art Groeneveld comments, "This partnership with Hyundai is perfect because we are both committed to keeping families safe in our vehicles. Hyundai's support has helped the Club take an important step in making sure kids are always safe in our buses. We can't thank them enough."

"I am thankful for this amazing program because I was able to continue my ESL classes while my two boys were being tutored and looked after at the Boys & Girls Club. Because I had been working and learned some English, I was placed in the Level 3-4 class. During these past 2 years, I know I have progressed a lot. When I started working, I was only a cashier. Now, I am also a waitress. Both of these positions have allowed me to practice my English skills. Now my English is much better, and I can communicate with others in ENGLISH!!! Not only that, the best part is that I can help my kids with their homework and I can talk to their teachers without anyone translating for me. I have complete confidence in speaking to people, even if I don't know them.

My overall experience at Twilight has been amazing. I have had the opportunity to meet many wonderful people – my teachers, my classmates, all of whom are my good friends today. Now my future plans are to get my

GED, then go to college to pursue my career as a medical assistant. I know that graduating from Twilight is only the beginning for me. I have a long road to success, but I know I can do it! Thank you for all your support and for always pushing me to be MORE!"

Thanks to you, Nancy is already earning more at a better job and is on her way to getting the education she needs to start on a new career path. She is working hard to do more and be more. Thank you for being a Boys &
